A cell site, cell phone tower, cell base tower, or cellular base station is a cellular -enabled mobile device site where antennas and electronic communications equipment are placed (typically on a radio mast, tower, or other raised structure) to create a cell, or adjacent cells, in a cellular network.

Cellular network is a wireless communication system that uses distributed base stations to provide connectivity to mobile devices within specific geographic areas.

Mobile communication is the process of transmitting voice, data, or multimedia between two devices that are not physically connected, typically over a wireless network.
