What happens if your ECM battery is disconnected?

Modern ECMs use memory to learn your driving habits. When the battery is disconnected, the learning process starts from scratch. You may notice a check engine light briefly appear or hear the engine sound different. This usually settles after 50 to 100 miles of normal driving.
